Greetings from the SELA Pet Food Pantry!

We have some exciting updates for the remainder of 2019 and want to share them with you! Please read carefully.

First, we would like to introduce everyone to the new and improved Pet Food Pantry. We have decided, at this point to concentrate on only helping St. Tammany Parish residence. This will change in the future. If you are currently in the pet food assistance program and have received at least six (6) consecutive months of pet food your assistance is ending. With that being said, we will now be conducting interviews, IN PERSON, to continue your assistance. This will allow us to update your information and renew your application. Interviews will be held on August 18, 2019 at Camp Salmen Nature Park, 35122 Parish Pkwy, Slidell, La 70460 from 12 noon to 1pm under the main pavilion. Once your IN PERSON interview is complete you will be mailed a letter, please be on the look out for it and read it carefully for instructions.

The pet food distribution dates for the remainder of 2019 will change to the 2nd Saturday of every month from 10am to 11am at 61109 Airport Road, Slidell, La 70460 in the parking lot of the old Petsmart building next to Academy.

Our new time for open enrollment to the Pet Food Pantry will be held on the 3rd Sunday of every month from 12 noon to 1pm at Camp Salmen Nature Park, 35122 Parish Pkwy, Slidell, La 70460 from 12 noon to 1pm under the main pavilion. So if you have friends or neighbors or know someone struggling to feed their pets, please let them know they can come to us and apply for help! Please have them bring proof of St. Tammany Parish residency, picture ID, and proof of combined family income of \$25,000 or less yearly to qualify, this includes everyone that lives in the household including children.

Since we mostly work off donated pet food you may receive kibble that is too large for your dog to eat. If they struggle with larger kibble, you can add a quarter cup of hot water to soften the food before serving.

Coming in 2020, SELAPFP is planning a low cost, trade, or nominal donation online thrift shop where you can browse online and shop for items that you and your pet will appreciate! If you have any clean pet items you would like to donate, please feel free to give us a call, text, email or Facebook message and we will arrange a pickup or you can drop it off to us at one of our distribution times.

We will now implement a bucket system for pet food distribution. We are in need of empty Tidy Cat, or similar, Litter buckets in the plastic 35-pound size and the red Folgers coffee cans 34.5 ounces, please save them for us!

If you still have pets that need to be spayed or neutered, St. Tammany Parish Animal Services has a discount voucher program through certain vets in St. Tammany Parish, please ask for a applications.
